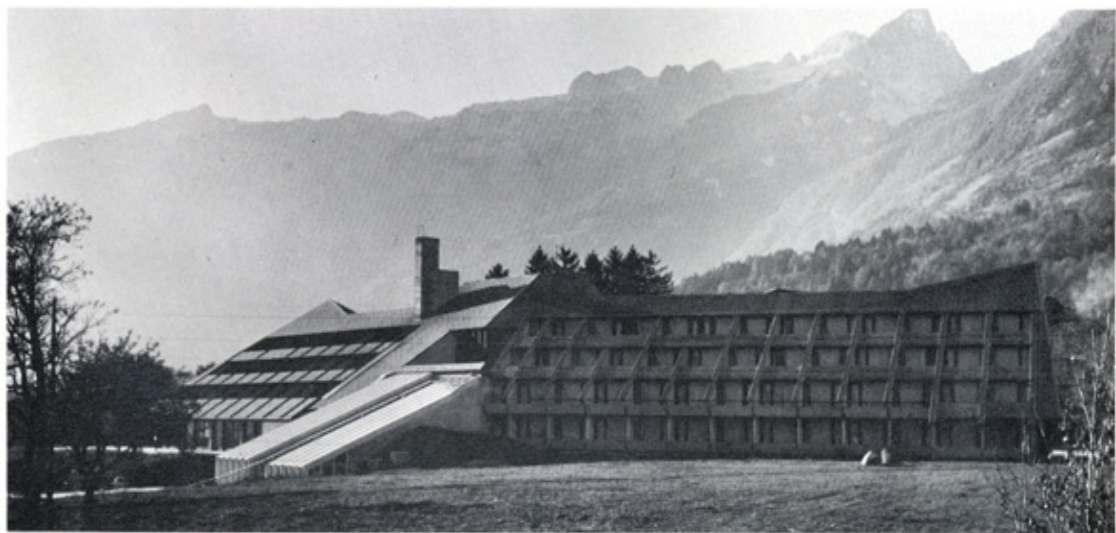

## Yugoslav design prize

The Hotel Kanin in Bovec, Slovenia, has won this year's architecture prize from the newspaper *Borba*. The 240-bed hotel in the Alps was designed by Janez Lajovic.

The architect attempted to avoid the clichés of the International Style, also resisting the opposite pull to picturesque regional expression so popular in mountain
